

Heubach India receives ICC award for Responsible Care for the year 2016

At a celebratory event held on Friday, September 29, 2017, at the Taj Mahal Palace & Towers, Gateway of India in Mumbai, the Indian Chemical Council (ICC) presented the ICC Aditya Birla Award for Best Responsible Care Committed Company to Heubach Color Pvt. Ltd., an affiliate of the Heubach Group.

Examples include the conversion of green solid waste into pharmaceutical aluminum hydroxide and the reduction of the Blue Phthalocyanin plant's urea consumption by 31% through process modifications.

At the social level, Heubach India provides exemplary financial support to the local hospital and has adopted a primary school. The company is a member of ETAD and Nicer Globe, an ICC initiative focusing on safe and secure transportation.
